



## **Community Partner Organization Guidelines**

In order to be considered as a bike recipient organization, potential community partners must meet the following requirements:

- Be 501(c)3 tax-exempt or public sector
- Work with children (ages 2-18 or still in high school)
- Distribute bikes primarily for children's use
- Be one of the following types of organizations:
  - Nonprofit or community organization serving primarily lower income youth/families
  - School or school district serving primarily lower income students
  - After-school programs, youth camps or sports team serving lower income youth/families
  - Established faith-based organization
  - Housing services, public/co-op housing, neighborhood associations serving primarily low income families
- Be located within a 50 mile radius of Atlanta, GA and/or must serve demographic within these boundaries Organizations that are based in Atlanta but send bikes to different states or countries do not meet this requirement
- Provide own transportation, and be willing and able to get to the warehouse to pick up bikes on the agreed date and time frame
